

### Your Wound Care Experts

You should consider our program if you are experiencing any of the following:

- · Wounds that are slow to heal or not healing
- · Foot or leg ulcers or wounds
- · Surgical wounds that have opened
- Skin grafts or surgical flaps that are not healing
- Internal injuries or open wounds caused by radiation therapy
- Bone infection (or osteomyelitis)
- Acute traumatic or crush injuries



# Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy

Hyperbaric Oxygen (HBO) Therapy is a treatment through which the patient breathes 100% pure oxygen while inside a pressurized chamber. The air pressure inside an HBO chamber is about two and a half times greater than the normal pressure in the atmosphere. This "hyperbaric" (or high pressure) dose of oxygen helps your blood carry more oxygen to organs and connective tissues to promote wound healing. It also activates the white blood cells to fight infection.

HBO Therapy can be the primary treatment or it can be used in combination with other treatments.

HBO Therapy is an outpatient procedure provided once daily for approximately four to six weeks. Treatments typically last approximately two hours and provide little to no discomfort for the majority of patients.
